Pemberton Historical Park

provides children and adults with an awareness of our history in the natural world, creating a sense of stewardship for our natural and cultural resources.

The Hall was built by Isaac Handy and his wife Anne in 1741 on the land that is now known as Pemberton Historical Park. The home and plantation were one of the first established in Wicomico County, and the Hall has been restored by its present owner, the Pemberton Hall Foundation.

Surrounding the Hall is more than 250 acres of land with 4.5 miles of walking trails. In this tranquil setting on the banks of the Wicomico River, you can walk in the footsteps of the people and wildlife that have passed here over thousands of years.

**DIRECTIONS TO
PEMBERTON HISTORICAL PARK:**

From the South: Take Rt. 13 Business into Salisbury. At the Rt. 50 overpass downtown, turn left onto Rt. 50 Business westbound. Travel over the Mill St. bridge and turn left onto Nanticoke Road (Rt. 349) at the 7-11. Make an immediate left turn onto Pemberton Drive. Continue straight on Pemberton Drive for 2.5 miles. The Park is located on the left about ¼ off the road.

From the North: Take Rt. 13 Business into Salisbury. At the Rt. 50 overpass downtown, turn right onto Rt. 50 Business westbound.
