Ride Across 300 Years of History

Wicomico County is
cycling country!

The roads are wide, and the even terrain makes it possible to enjoy any of the routes-- whether it's a 15, 32, 50 or 62 mile ride.

The tour route takes you through 300 years of Maryland history and along some of the most scenic roadways on the Eastern Shore.

The ride begins at Pemberton Hall in Salisbury, a plantation home built by one of Salisbury's founders in 1741. Common Grounds will be selling coffee and other breakfast items during registration.

From there, cyclers travel through scenic farmlands, historic villages, and tidewater marshes complete with great blue herons and bald eagles. Along the ride, rest areas are complete with sports drinks, iced water and healthy snacks, including fresh fruit.

The tour ends back at Pemberton Historical Park with an outdoor picnic offering soda, water, iced tea and live music until 2:30pm. Beer is also available for an extra charge.
